

Ultimate Do Up for HGTV Canada

HGTV Canada has taken on New Zealand home improvement format The Ultimate Do Up through a deal with Lone Eagle Distribution.

The 10x30' series will air on HGTV Canada in April next year, with the Alliance Atlantis Communications owned network committed to the original show as well as a local version.

Lone Eagle sold the series and format to HGTV, which it acquired through Screentime Partners, a UK indie with operations in Australia, New Zealand and Ireland.

Lone Eagle meanwhile, which has previously produced three seasons of Popstars, again licensed via Screentime, is currently in production on prime time comedy/reality hybrid The Office Temps.

The 10x60' series is being made in Canada for Global and has been picked up by Fox Studios and Fox Worldwide for co-production with Lone Eagle in the US.
