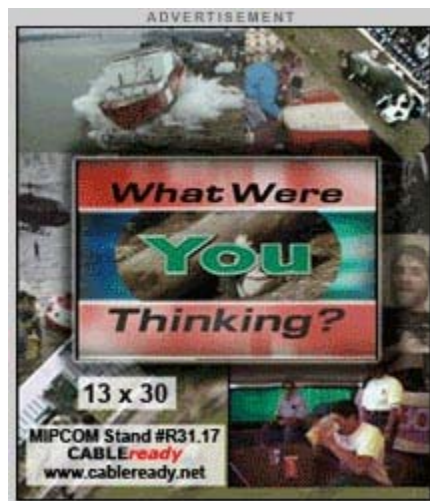


Lone Eagle gameshow takes off

Canadian format producer/distributor Lone Eagle Entertainment has kicked off production on the first season of a new high-tech race-against-the-clock gameshow destined for recently rebranded Canadian digital speciality channel TVtropolis.

Inside the Box (26x30') revolves around the content of iconic TV programming, pitting three contestants against one another as they try to identify memorable shows, actors and TV characters from the TV archives. The winner then progresses to the final round, competing against the clock for a cash prize.

Michael Geddes, executive producer and president of Lone Eagle Entertainment, called Inside the Box a "pressure-packed" show that delivers "great at-home playability."



The gameshow, which debuts in fall 2006, is an original production and was commissioned by TVtropolis, the Canwest Mediaworks network that was rebranded from Prime in May. Inside the Box will be distributed as both a finished show and as a worldwide format.
